New York State Drinking Water Certification Status for 1,2-Dibromoethane and 1,2-Dibromo- 3-Chloropropane

Updated: July 21, 2014

New York Drinking Water Certification

NY ELAP will be removing certification for 1,2-Dibromoethane and 1,2-Dibromo-3-Chloropropane by the GC-MS method, EPA 524.2.

Certification will still remain for these parameters by GC/Microextractable method, EPA 504.1.

This change affects the drinking water matrix ONLY and does not apply to other aqueous matrix types.

This change will occur on July 31, 2014 and applies to all New York certified laboratories.
